BUILDING FUND OBLIGATION:

Age	Family	Single
32 & under	Deferred until one member of the household reaches Age 33	
33-64	\$ 6,000	\$ 3,000

NOTES: As a new member, payments are deferred for 2 years before paying 6 annual installments of \$1,000 per year (33-64 family) or \$500 per year (65 & over family). A new member who has paid a building fund to another reform congregation may apply 100% of those payments made to Temple Emanu-El's Building Fund with confirmation from the previous synagogue.

DUES ASSISTANCE

Please contact Stephen Blick, Executive Director, if you find that extenuating circumstances necessitate a delay in payment or require special financial arrangements. All requests for dues relief are subject to review by the Dues Relief Committee and all information will be kept strictly confidential.

MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING

Per the Temple Emanu-El Constitution, members who are more than 60 days in arrears and who have not made special financial arrangements are subject to not receiving their High Holy Day Tickets and resignation as determined by the Board of Trustees.

RELIGIOUS SCHOOL FEES:

To register for religious school, all prior commitments must be met. New members, please visit our website for registration. Scholarships or special payment plans are available based on need and will be addressed individually.

BAR/BAT MITZVAH:

For your child to become a Bar/Bat Mitzvah, all fees must be paid and your dues commitment must be current.

HIGH HOLIDAY TICKETS:

To receive High Holy Days Tickets, congregants must be in good standing (see Member in Good Standing Section). Dues, assessments, religious school fees, building fund fees, Bar/Bat Mitzvah fees and other charges must be current. Dues and assessments can be paid on a monthly, quarterly or yearly basis. Dues and assessments are to be paid at the beginning of each period.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

There are 4 options available to make your payment:

- 1) ACH (automatic draft from a checking account) – incurs no processing fee
- 2) Personal Check
- 3) Credit Card (incurs 3% credit card fee)
- 4) Donate Appreciated Stock, Mutual Funds, IRA, and Required Minimum Distributions
